Behaviour

Our Behaviour for learning policy promotes good behaviour across the Campus. <https://www.cranbrookeducationcampus.org.uk/about-us/behaviour-rewards/> Campus expectations are displayed in all classrooms to remind pupils of how to be successful. For pupils who are not meeting expectations there is a system of escalating sanctions, (including same day end of day detentions for Secondary pupils) plus additional support available. If a pupil is set a detention they must attend unless a parent/carer has contacted the Inclusion Room with a valid reason. Please note that the Campus will take action on behaviour that occurs during the Campus day, on the way to and from the Campus and at any other time that pupils are identifiable as a Cranbrook pupil.

Attendance

Pupils should arrive at the Campus every day on time (EYFS & Primary – 08:50am, Secondary 08:35am). Any pupils arriving after this time must sign in at reception. If they are unwell then please contact the Campus every day they are absent via telephone on 01404 823293.

Homework

All homework will be set on ClassCharts. Pupils and their parent/carer have their own individual access. All homework should be completed on time. Any concerns or support needed is requested before the deadline. If a pupil is absent then they are STILL expected to complete homework set and to catch up on work missed.

Awards & Rewards

Pupils will receive regular rewards and recognition of their excellent work and to reinforce and praise Campus expectations. Pupils will be awarded House Points linked to our key expectations. These can be seen via ClassCharts. Pupils will be invited to regular reward events (half termly in Primary and termly in Secondary) if they have excellent attendance and positive behaviour ratio's. Pupils are awarded Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum house point badges, receive certificates in praise assemblies and for subject specific achievements.
